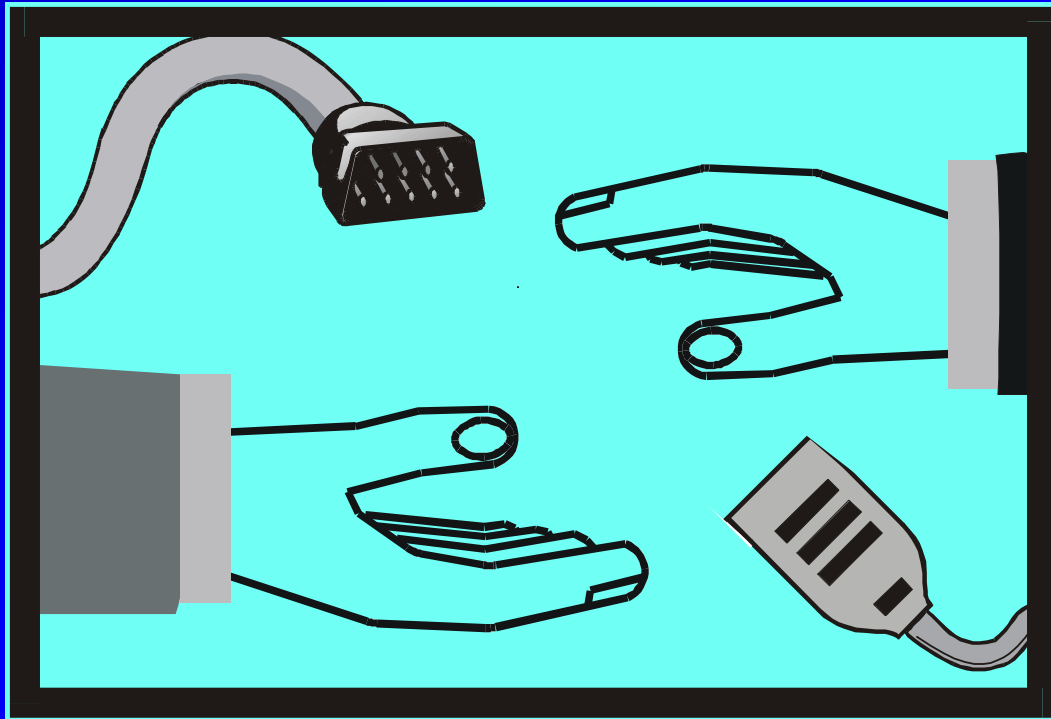

Overview- NCV ECS Web Page

- **Recent Webpage Activity:**
- 1083 unique hits in April
 - Greater linkage throughout the web has led to increased site activity
 - Average of 34 hits per day in April
 - Peaked with 56 hits in one day!

Home Page

- Address: www.obdiicsu.com
- Webpage mission is to provide a comprehensive clearinghouse of information relating to OBD II, for diverse audiences
- Targeted to four main audiences:
 - I/M Administrators
 - Auto Technicians
 - The Driving Public
 - Educators

Home Page (continued)

- Main section is dynamic and will display whatever topics you select
 - On the left are topic buttons to aid you in navigating through the site.
 - Help button on left also contains information on:
 - Browser requirements
 - Access information
 - Forum access info
 - How to contact the web administrator

I/M Administrators Page

- Page is designed specifically for professionals who work in I/M programs.
 - OBD document resource page contains most of the major OBD II regulations that have been issued by EPA and CARB. Documents reside on this page, eliminating links.
 - Clean Air Conference topics on OBD II contains all presentations from last three CAC pertaining to OBD II
 - The human factor's research page contains a synopsis of NCVECS research regarding the public's perceptions, knowledge and information needs.

I/M Administrators Page

- Page is designed specifically for professionals who work in I/M programs.
 - The OBD II PR Study page presents a NCVACS study looking at state I/M programs. A list of questions and recommendations were developed, based on this study for use by states developing and implementing OBD II outreach programs. Outreach materials were also collected and are presented in the appendices to this study.
 - Collecting and posting I/M PR materials collected from states who have developed them. We are posting these for those states who are looking for ideas for their PR materials

Auto Technicians Homepage

- Page is designed specifically for working automotive Technicians.
 - Includes a database of OBD II training providers with course descriptions, target audiences and contact information.
 - Also includes a OBD II scan tool database, which includes manufacturer info and product descriptions.

Auto Technicians Homepage

- Page is designed specifically for working automotive Technicians.
 - The OBD II Port Connector Pin Assignments- page defines the DLC requirements for OBD II.
 - Repair Case Studies- Real world examples of OBD II repairs moving from diagnosis through repair to final follow-up.

Auto Technicians Homepage

- Page is designed specifically for working automotive Technicians.
 - Customer Fact Sheet Simplified sheet for shop customers that answers their questions while educating them about OBD II. Helps standardize OBD II answers given to repair shop customers.
 - Other Links Links for use in the diagnosis and repair of OBD II vehicles.
 - This page also contains information on OBD II technical studies, regulatory information, state programs and DTCs.

Driving Public Homepage

- -Purpose of this section is to provide factual information about OBD II to owner's of cars equipped with OBD II. Three documents on this page answer most driver's questions:
 - EPA's FAQ sheet, OBD II FAQ and the Customer Fact Sheet.
 - Open Forum This forum is open to anyone who has a question or information to share about OBD II.

Driving Public Homepage

- The open forum has seen significant increase in activity over the past five months, seeing more than triple the average number of hits in April, 2002 over January, 2002.
- Other Links- Has a link to EPA's Green Vehicle Guide and other useful information for the public.
